MASTER OF ACCOUNTING

When you earn a Master of Accounting degree, you open up more opportunities for careers in public accounting firms, private industry and government agencies. WSU’s fully-accredited MAcc program, offered through the John B. Goddard School of Business & Economics, meets working students’ needs by holding classes in the afternoons and evenings at the conveniently located Davis campus in Layton. To graduate, you must earn 30 credit hours, after which you can sit for the Certified Public Accountant Examination in Utah.

MASTER OF TAXATION

WSU’s fully-accredited Master of Taxation program will give you the knowledge and skills you need to find success as a tax professional. To graduate with an MTax degree, you must complete 30 credit hours. Designed for working professionals, classes are scheduled in the afternoons and evenings at the Davis campus in Layton. A full-time student typically completes the program in two semesters.

Students who earn their MTax degrees, and have also had upper division or graduate courses in financial accounting, managerial accounting and auditing, are eligible to sit for the CPA Examination in Utah.
